HEAD OF SCHOOL MESSAGE

Dear Broadwater Family,

We did it.

Together, we strengthened our School and served Eastern Shore community and families in profound, meaningful ways. This edition of Tideline details how our immediate and extended family, along with friends of the school, have collaborated to strengthen Broadwater to be families' trusted partner to raise their children on the Shore.

The pandemic continues onward and yet our ability to adapt, improvise, be flexible and nimble has served our students and families well. Throughout all of last year we were guided by the theme, It's a New Day, to reflect the changes in the world and also at Broadwater. We accomplished what few schools in the mid-Atlantic could do. We were open for in-person learning for the entire school year without interruption. The academic, social, physical, emotional and overall developmental needs of our students are central to all our decision making.



Two school years ago, we opened with 272 students. For the 2020-21 school year, we opened with 289 students and grew throughout the school year to 305 students. While we gained momentum and enhanced our educational practices, we invested in technology in order to serve families who chose remote learning for short terms or for the entire year. This was also necessary due to the amount of offerings that transitioned to online formats, such as Model General Assembly. This effort remains on-going and has made us better in all aspects of program delivery.

Our varsity athletes competed throughout the school year at a high level, earning conference and state-level honors in many areas. Our performing artists were able to stage live productions partnering with WESR for musical radio show concerts and also over the internet offering theatrical productions. The pandemic didn't slow down our students' efforts to develop as young people outside the classroom.

Of course, none of this would be possible without extraordinary support of a wide and diverse group. Thank you. Thank you for fueling the momentum forward for Broadwater Academy. Though circumstances remain challenging, I do look forward to connecting with as many of you as possible throughout the year to update you on all the excitement our faculty and students are generating. Broadwater is a school on the move and greater things lay ahead.

Together, we will realize a bright future for our students.

We were able to adopt Broadwater Road again after two trash pick-up days throughout the school year.







We hosted Daffodil Day and provided over 150 bouquets of daffodils to local nursing homes.




