Application Requirements:

- 1) Apply for Tuition Assistance through FAST by the deadlines (December 15, 2018 for returning families; March 1, 2019 for new families);
- 2) If you are a new student, complete the Application for Admission, which includes testing and receipt of school records;
- 3) Email the following two requirements by the deadlines (January 15, 2019 for returning families; March 1, 2019 for new families) to Sheila Sheppard, Director of Admissions, ssheppard@broadwateracademy.org with the subject: Scholarship Application.

- One letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator who has direct experience with the student;
- A 500-word typed essay, in the student's own words with no outside assistance, addressing the following question:

How do you feel a Broadwater education will help you achieve your goals?

The Broadwater Academy Scholarship Review Committee will determine the awards.

NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Friends of Broadwater Scholarships: \$500-\$2,000 KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 12

Since 2017, Broadwater Academy has benefited from the generosity of the Friends of Broadwater Scholarship Program. In 2017, Broadwater distributed \$49,334 to 42 students. In 2018, Broadwater distributed \$65,000 to 44 students. These scholarship awards ensure that a Broadwater Academy education is within reach for the Shore's families.

Hampton Roads Community Foundation Scholarships: Up to \$5,882 KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 12

Broadwater Academy students, for the third year, can now access tax credit funds through the Hampton Roads Community Foundation. For example, a family of four earning less than \$75,000 would qualify. Only students transferring from a public school, or students entering Kindergarten, new Virginia resident transfers, or previous recipients are eligible.

The Sarah and Jennifer Byler Memorial Scholarship: \$4,000 PRE-KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 12

This Memorial Scholarship was established in 2018 to ensure that an Eastern Shore student could benefit from a Broadwater Academy education who would otherwise be unable to do so.

Eligibility will be determined by the FAST application. No other application is necessary. Apply online:
