

## 2019 - 2020 School Supply List

### GRADE 5

**Math and Science:** a 3-ring binder with plastic insert dividers, loose leaf paper, pack of standard size graph paper, basic calculator with +, -, /, X functions, ruler, supply of eraser tops, sharpened pencils and cloth pencil case.

**Language Arts and History:** 2 composition notebooks, 2" binder with and plastic insert dividers, loose leaf paper and 1 plastic folder

*Students should also have a daily planner, loose leaf paper, pencils, pens, erasers, highlighter, glue sticks, colored pencils, earbuds compatible with chrome book, and index cards. Parents should periodically restock the paper, pen, and pencil supply for each student.*

### GRADE 6

**Math/Language Arts:** One two-inch binder (will share binder for english/math), a set of dividers (at least 8), pencils, a ruler, two folders, a calculator with basic functions and exponents, colored pencils, and loose leaf paper

**Science:** Three-section spiral notebook with built in pockets and sturdy 3-prong folder

**US History II:** Three-section spiral notebook with built in pockets, and sturdy 3-prong folder

*Students should also have a daily planner, loose leaf paper, pencils, pens, thin tip Crayola markers, earbuds compatible with chromebook, and erasers for all classes. Parents should periodically restock the paper, pen, and pencil supply for each student.*

### GRADE 7

**Math:** dry erase markers (large pack that needs to be replenished throughout the year) composition notebook, math binder (1-2"), scientific calculator (Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS Scientific Calculator), straightedge, small protractor, pencils, color pencils or markers

**Science:** 3-ring binder, 3-prong pocket folder, scientific calculator (same one used in math)

**Language Arts:** 2 hardback composition books, dry-erase marker, 500+ sticky notes, folder with pockets

**World History I:** 3-ring binder, 1 sturdy 9" X 12" two pocket folder, 1 small pencil sharpener, 1 hardback composition book, 12 pack of color pencils

*Students should also have a daily planner, laptop or chromebook, loose leaf paper, pens, pencils, and erasers for all classes. Parents should periodically restock the paper, pen, and pencil supply for each student. Students should also have headphones or earbuds to be used with technology, and an 8 GB (minimum) flash drive.*

### GRADE 8

**Math:** Composition notebook, binder (1-2"), calculator (Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS Scientific Calculator or (optional-Graphing Calculator TI 83 or TI 84), dry erase markers (large pack), straightedge,

**Science:** 3-ring binder, 3-prong pocket folder, scientific calculator (same one used in math)

**Language Arts:** 2 hardback composition books, dry-erase marker, 500+ sticky notes, folder with pockets

**World History II:** 3-ring binder, 1 sturdy 9" X 12" two pocket folder, 1 small pencil sharpener, 1 hardback composition book, 12 pack of color pencils
